



Examples of Community Service

Students have many opportunities to complete the community service requirement for the Work Ethic Certification. The hours may be completed in the community at large or at school. Any activity where the student volunteers their time is acceptable, provided the student receives no monetary compensation or, if completed at school, they do not receive a grade/credit for the work. The list included below includes examples of organizations, locations or tasks that fulfill the community service requirement. This is not a comprehensive list and other acts of community service can be completed by the student. It is important for any student pursuing the LCSC Work Ethic Certification submit their documentation of community service hours by visit www.leb.k12.in.us/WECservicehours. Community service hours must be completed from September 15th until May 1st. All documentation must be completed by May 1st.
