Class hours are as follows:

Please note:

- If a student registers for summer school it is understood that your student has a seat reserved and the student should report for their class at the appropriate time on June 3rd.
- Transportation service is not available for summer school.
- Cafeteria service is not available for summer school. Students taking the AM and PM sessions will need to pack a lunch.
- Students may miss only one day of summer school in order to complete the class requirements and obtain credit for the course. 3 tardies = 1 absence

To drop from a summer school class the student must communicate with Mrs. VanDokkenburg no later than May 30th. Failure to notify Mrs. VanDokkenburg will result in a W/F.

Any student that attends summer school but does not complete the course will receive a withdrawal/failure (WF). This equates to an "F" into the students GPA.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Physical Education is a required one-year course for freshmen. The course is designed to develop physical skills, to improve muscle tone, to encourage teamwork and sportsmanship. The development of comprehensive knowledge of rules, techniques, and strategies is part of the program. The program is divided into various areas of concentration with emphasis on activities such as aerobics, swimming, team games, and lifetime fitness.

Students must successfully complete an additional semester of P.E. to satisfy graduation requirement.
