The following is a list of current scholarships. The deadlines can sneak up on you, so if you are interested in any of them, get started on your applications ASAP! Scholarship information is also available on the school website, at www.leb.k12.in.us. See your counselor with any questions.

****Lebanon Educational Foundation Scholarships:** The Lebanon Educational Foundation awards a variety of scholarships based on academic excellence, athletics, community involvement, path of study, financial need, or simply pursuit of further education whether it be **vocational programs or two- or four-year colleges or universities**. Only one application needs to be completed for a multitude of available scholarships offered to LHS students through the Lebanon Educational Foundation. Many factors will be considered in the selection process. Applicants are encouraged to read the criteria for each individual scholarship when completing the application. Visit the Lebanon Educational Foundation website at www.lebanonlef.org to get the application. All applications are due to the **Student Services Office by 3:00 pm Friday, February 2nd, 2024**.

****Community Foundation of Boone County Scholarships:** The Community Foundation offers a wide variety of scholarships to high school seniors in Boone County. Requirements vary and everyone is encouraged to apply. Some scholarships are open to all Boone County seniors and others are open only to students from a particular high school. Applications are due **Tuesday, February 6th, 2024 at 12:00 pm**.

The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship: The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship provides 200 high-achieving high school & college students interested in pursuing a career in education the opportunity to earn a renewable scholarship of up to \$7,500 each year for four academic years. In exchange, students agree to teach for five years at an eligible Indiana school or **repay** the corresponding, prorated amount of the scholarship. Tri Kappa Scholarship: This scholarship is awarded locally to a graduating senior accepted in a 2 or 4 year program in an accredited school. This is a general scholarship. Amount will vary - usually \$1000. Interview with Scholarship Committee and two letters of recommendation are required. See Student Services for an application. Application must be postmarked by **February 1st, 2024**.

Big Futures Scholarship Search: Class of 2024 Students Can Qualify for \$40K by Starting Their Scholarship List! Students in the class of 2024 who use [BigFuture Scholarship Search](#) and save three scholarships to their list will earn entries in monthly drawings for \$500 and \$40,000 scholarships that can be applied to 2 or 4-year colleges or universities. Students can search for [more than 23,000 scholarships](#) on BigFuture, based on their background, interests, and future plans. Log in to BigFuture to get started. For the class of 2024, \$500 and \$40,000 are awarded monthly **until February 2024**.

Boone County Right to Life Scholarship: The Boone County Right to Life organization is hosting a scholarship essay competition. Applicants must be high school seniors in Boone County and submit an essay on a given topic. Scholarships of up to \$500 will be awarded. Application information is available in Student Services. Application deadline is **March 5th, 2024**.

Boone County Retired Teachers Association Future Teacher Awards: The Boone County Retired Teachers Association will be awarding one or more \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors in Boone County who will be attending a 4-year college next fall and pursuing a career in the field of education. Applications are available in the Student Services office. Application deadline is **March 15th, 2024**.

Horatio Alger Association Scholarships: The Horatio Alger Association offers a variety of scholarships to both juniors and seniors who have critical financial need, demonstrate integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity and are determined to succeed. LHS SPORTS BOOSTERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS:

Parents must be members of the Lebanon Sports Boosters as of 12/31/2021. Two \$1,000 scholarships- one to a senior boy athlete and one to senior girl athlete. Must be a 3-year athlete or have 2 varsity letters and a GPA of 2.5 or better with plans to attend a 2 or 4-year college or university. Application deadline is **3 pm, March 21st, 2024**, to the Student Services Office.

Orchard Project Scholarship: The Old Town Design Group, LLC, a custom homebuilder located in Carmel IN, believes by investing in the success of today's students they are investing in the success of tomorrow's home building industry. They have established the Orchard Project Scholarship to provide tuition assistance to a Hamilton, Boone or Johnson County student preparing for a career in the construction industry. Indiana Workforce Ready Grant: The Next Level Jobs Workforce Ready Grant pays the **tuition and mandatory fees** for eligible high-value certificate programs at Ivy Tech Community College, Vincennes University, Indiana Institute of Technology, or other approved providers. The grant is available for two (2) years and covers up to the number of credits required by the qualifying program. Programs include Advanced Manufacturing, Building & Construction, Health Sciences, IT & Business Services, and Transportation & Logistics.
