**\*\*Lebanon Educational Foundation Scholarships:** The Lebanon Educational Foundation awards a variety of scholarships based on academic excellence, athletics, community involvement, path of study, financial need, or simply pursuit of further education whether it be **vocational programs or two- or four-year colleges or universities**. Only one application needs to be completed for a multitude of available scholarships offered to LHS students through the Lebanon Educational Foundation. Many factors will be considered in the selection process. Applicants are encouraged to read the criteria for each individual scholarship when completing the application. All applications are due to the **Student Services Office by 3:00 pm Friday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**.

**\*\*Community Foundation of Boone County Scholarships:** The Community Foundation offers a wide variety of scholarships to high school seniors in Boone County. Requirements vary and everyone is encouraged to apply. Some scholarships are open to all Boone County seniors and others are open only to students from a particular high school. **The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship:** The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship provides 200 high-achieving high school & college students interested in pursuing a career in education the opportunity to earn a renewable scholarship of up to \$7,500 each year for four academic years. In exchange, students agree to teach for five years at an eligible Indiana school or **repay** the corresponding, prorated amount of the scholarship. **Big Futures Scholarship Search:** Class of 2024 Students Can Qualify for \$40K by Starting Their Scholarship List! Students in the class of 2024 who use [BigFuture Scholarship Search](#) and save three scholarships to their list will earn entries in monthly drawings for \$500 and \$40,000 scholarships that can be applied to 2 or 4-year colleges or universities. Students can search for [more than 23,000 scholarships](#) on BigFuture, based on their background, interests, and future plans. Log in to BigFuture to get started. For the class of 2024, \$500 and \$40,000 are awarded monthly **until February 2024**.

## **LHS SPORTS BOOSTERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS:**

Parents must be members of the Lebanon Sports Boosters as of 12/31/2021. Two \$1,000 scholarships- one to a senior boy athlete and one to senior girl athlete. Must be a 3-year athlete or have 2 varsity letters and a GPA of 2.5 or better with plans to attend a 2 or 4-year college or university. Application deadline is **3 pm, March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024**, to the Student Services Office.

**Indiana Workforce Ready Grant:** The Next Level Jobs Workforce Ready Grant pays the **tuition and mandatory fees** for eligible high-value certificate programs at Ivy Tech Community College, Vincennes University, Indiana Institute of Technology, or other approved providers. The grant is available for two (2) years and covers up to the number of credits required by the qualifying program. Programs include Advanced Manufacturing, Building & Construction, Health Sciences, IT & Business Services, and Transportation & Logistics.
