****Lebanon Educational Foundation Vocational Scholarships:** The Lebanon Educational Foundation awards a variety of scholarships based on academic excellence, athletics, community involvement, path of study, financial need, or simply pursuit of further education in **vocational programs or two-year colleges**. Only one application needs to be completed for a multitude of available scholarships offered to LHS students through the Lebanon Educational Foundation. Many factors will be considered in the selection process. Applicants are encouraged to read the criteria for each individual scholarship when completing the application. Big Futures Scholarship Search: Class of 2024 Students Can Qualify for \$40K by Starting Their Scholarship List! Students in the class of 2024 who use [BigFuture Scholarship Search](#) and save three scholarships to their list will earn entries in monthly drawings for \$500 and \$40,000 scholarships that can be applied to 2 or 4-year colleges or universities. Students can search for [more than 23,000 scholarships](#) on BigFuture, based on their background, interests, and future plans. Log in to BigFuture to get started. For the class of 2024, \$500 and \$40,000 are awarded monthly **until February 2024.**

Hagan Scholarship Foundation: This program offers the opportunity for high achieving, high financial need students to graduate college debt free. Applicants must have at least a 3.5 GPA, attend a 4-year college or university beginning next fall, be on track to graduate from college and have worked 240 hours. Witham Health Service's Volunteer Health Career Scholarship: \$1,000 scholarship offered to a Boone County senior who is entering a health career field. Financial aid is not a factor. Applications are available in Student Services. Application deadline is **12 pm on March 1st, 2024, to the Student Services office.**

Purdue Club of Boone County Scholarship: This minimum \$500 scholarship is awarded to a Boone County high school senior who will be attending Purdue University next fall. Selection criteria includes: academic achievement, activities & school involvement, community involvement, financial need and Purdue commitment. Boone County Right to Life Scholarship: The Boone County Right to Life organization is hosting a scholarship essay competition. Applicants must be high school seniors in Boone County and submit an essay on a given topic. Scholarships of up to \$500 will be awarded. Application information is available in Student Services. Application deadline is **March 5th, 2024.**

Boone County Retired Teachers Association Future Teacher Awards: The Boone County Retired Teachers Association will be awarding one or more \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors in Boone County who will be attending a 4-year college next fall and pursuing a career in the field of education. Applications are available in the Student Services office. Application deadline is **March 15th, 2024.**

Horatio Alger Association Scholarships: The Horatio Alger Association offers a variety of scholarships to both juniors and seniors who have critical financial need, demonstrate integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity and are determined to succeed. LHS SPORTS BOOSTERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS:

Parents must be members of the Lebanon Sports Boosters as of 12/31/2021. Two \$1,000 scholarships- one to a senior boy athlete and one to senior girl athlete. Must be a 3-year athlete or have 2 varsity letters and a GPA of 2.5 or better with plans to attend a 2 or 4-year college or university. The scholarship is available to any male, senior graduating high school who is enrolling in a four-year undergraduate college program that commences in the fall. The scholarship is awarded through the Foundation for Fraternal Excellence, a registered 501(c)3 organization. **Current or future membership in a fraternity is not required.** Multiple scholarships will be awarded in amounts of \$500-1,000 USD. Indiana Sheriffs' Association Scholarship Program: This scholarship is for an Indiana resident committed to pursuing an education and career in criminal justice at an Indiana college or university. Forty \$750 scholarships will be awarded. All applicants must be a current member of the association, or a dependent child or grandchild of a current member of the association. (If you do not meet this requirement you may join as part of your scholarship application). Also, all applicants must have taken the SAT or ACT. Student-View Scholarship Program: The Student-View Scholarship Program is offering over \$14,000 worth of scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend a four-year, two-year, community college or trade school. All Indiana seniors who apply will automatically be entered into the drawing for the new \$500 Indiana Senior Scholarship. To apply, log on to www.student-view.com and complete the application survey. Application deadline is **April 23rd, 2024.**

First Responders Heat and Cool Mechanical Trades Scholarship: This scholarship will be awarded to one Boone County senior who is currently in or planning to go/continue in a mechanical trade (including but not limited to electrician, plumbing, HVAC, welding, machinist, locksmith, etc.) For more information and an application, see your counselor. American Public Works Scholarship: The Indiana Chapter of the American Public Works Association would like to offer a scholarship to Indiana high school seniors. The scholarship is awarded to a high school senior who would pursue a degree program in a public works related field. Such fields would include Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Parks and Recreation, Municipal Planning, Public Administration Public Works/Municipal Operations and Fleet management among others. The degree may be through a university or technical school course of study. The scholarship awards \$1000.00 annually for 4 years if the student demonstrates continued progress toward a public works field degree. A paid annual membership to the American Public Works Association is included in the award. The grant is available for two (2) years and covers up to the number of credits required by the qualifying program. Programs include Advanced Manufacturing, Building & Construction, Health Sciences, IT & Business Services, and Transportation & Logistics.
