MASKS AND FACE COVERINGS

DISTRICT PRECAUTIONS

COLLABORATION WITH LOCAL AND STATE HEALTH OFFICIALS

Lebanon Community School Corporation will continue to collaborate with local and state health officials and follow guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control in order to maintain adherence to best practices in the following:

- Contact tracing (currently not required by CDC or State Department of Health)
- Isolation and quarantine for exposures (Individuals with positive cases asked to follow CDC guidelines)
- Face masks (Not required. Individuals make own informed choice regarding use)
- Daily operations, including:
 - Meal service
 - Passing periods
 - Recess
 - School visitors and volunteers
 - Transportation
