PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION REGISTRATION

Lebanon Community School District is committed to providing a safe environment for students and staff. It seeks to prevent children from being exposed to pests and pesticides. Therefore, pest control practices may involve a variety of chemical and non-chemical methods that are designed to control pests effectively while minimizing potential pesticide exposure. Pesticides will be applied by a certified pesticide applicator when students and staff members are not present, such as non-instructional time or school vacation periods. Parents, guardians and staff will be notified of pesticide application at the school if they register with the school district to receive advanced notice.

As part of a school pest management plan Lebanon School Corporation may use pesticides to control pests. In compliance with the Indiana Pesticide Notification Title 357, you may request to be added to the pesticide notification registry by calling the Facilities Department at (765) 483-3088. A copy of the Lebanon School District's Integrated Pest Management Plan is available at the Service Center. Questions may be directed to the Facilities Department.
