Thank you LCSC community for a great start to the 2021-22 school year! It is so rewarding to see all of the wonderful teaching and learning taking place in our classrooms and to see our Tigers representing LCSC in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

We have updated our [FAQ section of our COVID-19 Website](#). Please review this important information regarding:

- What to do when your child is sick;
- Procedures in determining when a person must be excluded from physically attending school or work;
- Procedures in determining when a person may return to school or work;
- The COVID-19 tests and test results that are required upon return to school or work.

I am confident that many of you are curious about our COVID-19 data. As of August 13, 2021 one (1) student positive case was reported and zero (0) staff positive cases or exclusions due to COVID-19 was reported.

Families using LCSC bus transportation are reminded that the Indiana Department of Education Director of Transportation, the Federal Transportation Safety Administration, and the Indiana Department of Health has determined masks or face coverings **must be worn** on school buses and school transportation. **Students must follow this requirement in order to continue the use of LCSC bus transportation.**

The district will continue to frequently clean high-touch surfaces, including the use of UV-C light source sanitizing devices and additional air filtration. Plexiglass barriers will remain installed. Students and staff are encouraged to bring hand sanitizer and/or visit sanitizing stations regularly. The district will continue to review precautions regarding meal services, visitors, and classroom guidelines in consultation with the Boone County Health Department.
