PHASE 5 OVERVIEW

All schools will open on time, five days per week, for in-person instruction. Guidelines and modifications will be implemented to promote a safe learning and working environment.

Instruction will be provided in-person, with a remote option for students unable to attend in person.

HEALTH + SAFETY GUIDELINES

MASKS

We strongly encourage all students and employees to wear face coverings. Students will be encouraged to protect themselves and others by wearing a mask, especially:

- On the bus to and from school
- In hallways and during passing periods
- When social distancing is not possible

Students will be required to wear a mask when visiting the clinic.

PERSONAL SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS

Supplies and materials may not be shared.

PROTECTIVE MEASURES

Students and staff are encouraged to bring hand sanitizer for personal use. We have purchased additional inventory of CDC-approved hand sanitizer and sanitary wipes.

SANITIZING AND CLEANING

Ultraviolet light sanitizing devices will be added to our regular cleaning routines. Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned often.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT UPDATES

BUILDING MODIFICATIONS

Seating will be modified and/or expanded in cafeterias and classrooms to promote social distancing.

CAFETERIA

Cash transactions are limited. Additional utensils will be provided. All self-service is eliminated.

RECESS

Elementary students will participate in recess. Sustained close contact activities are not permitted. Equipment will be disinfected daily.

SCHOOL ENTRY/EXIT

Building entrances and exits will be staggered to avoid overcrowding.

TRANSPORTATION

Student seating is limited. Busses will be cleaned daily between routes.

VISITORS AND VOLUNTEERS

No visitors are permitted. Volunteers are limited, with screening and training required.
