

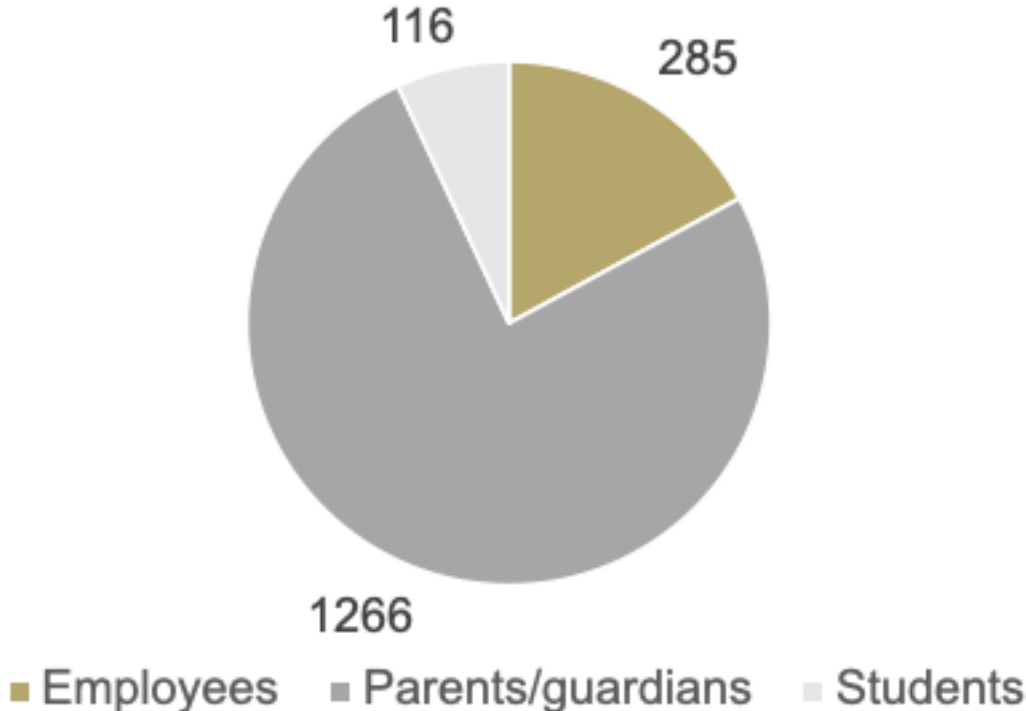

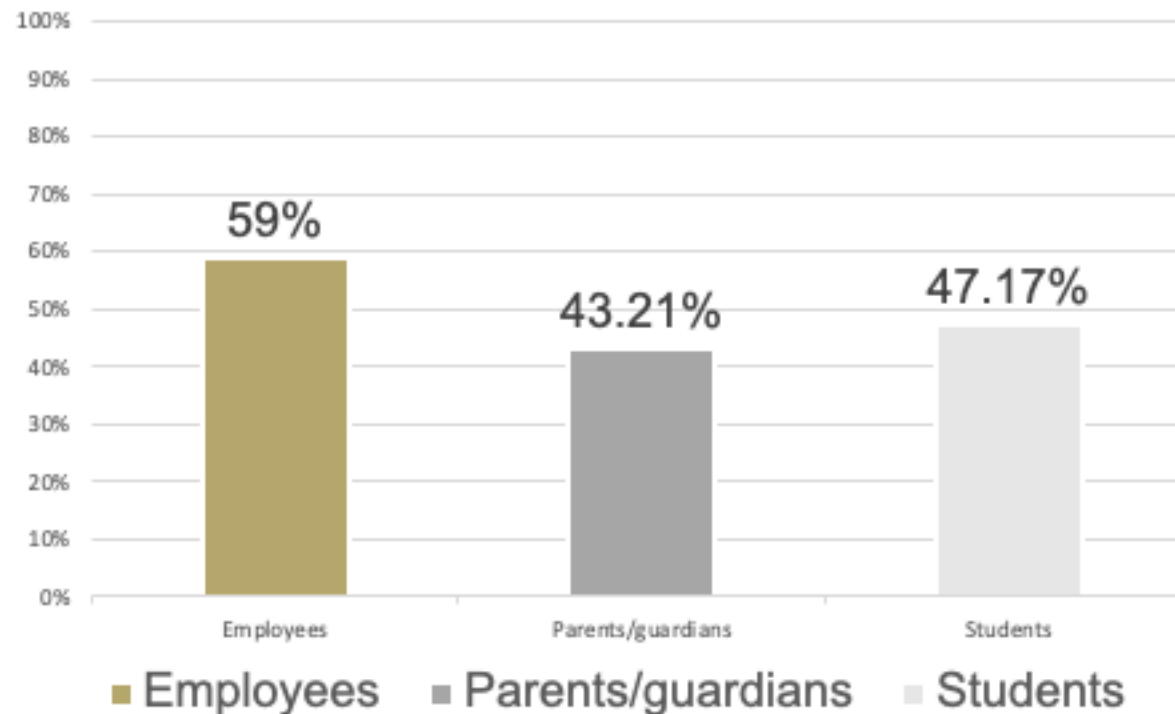

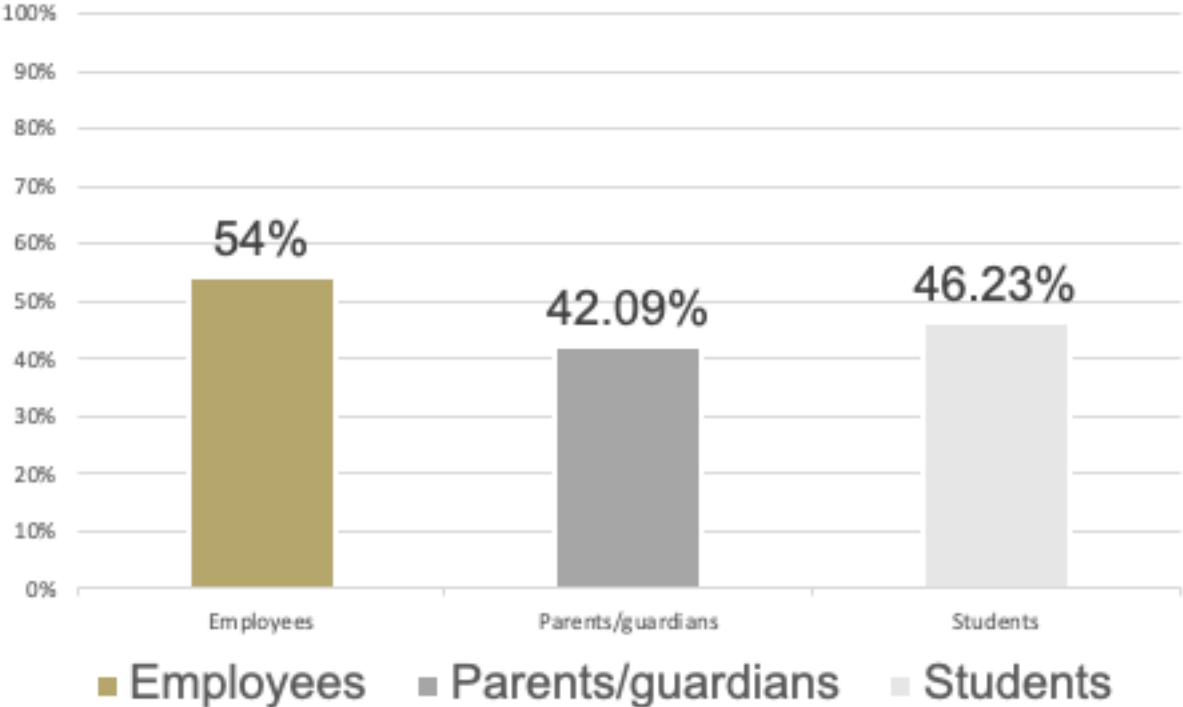

Reported access to eLearning assignments as *quite* or *extremely* easy:

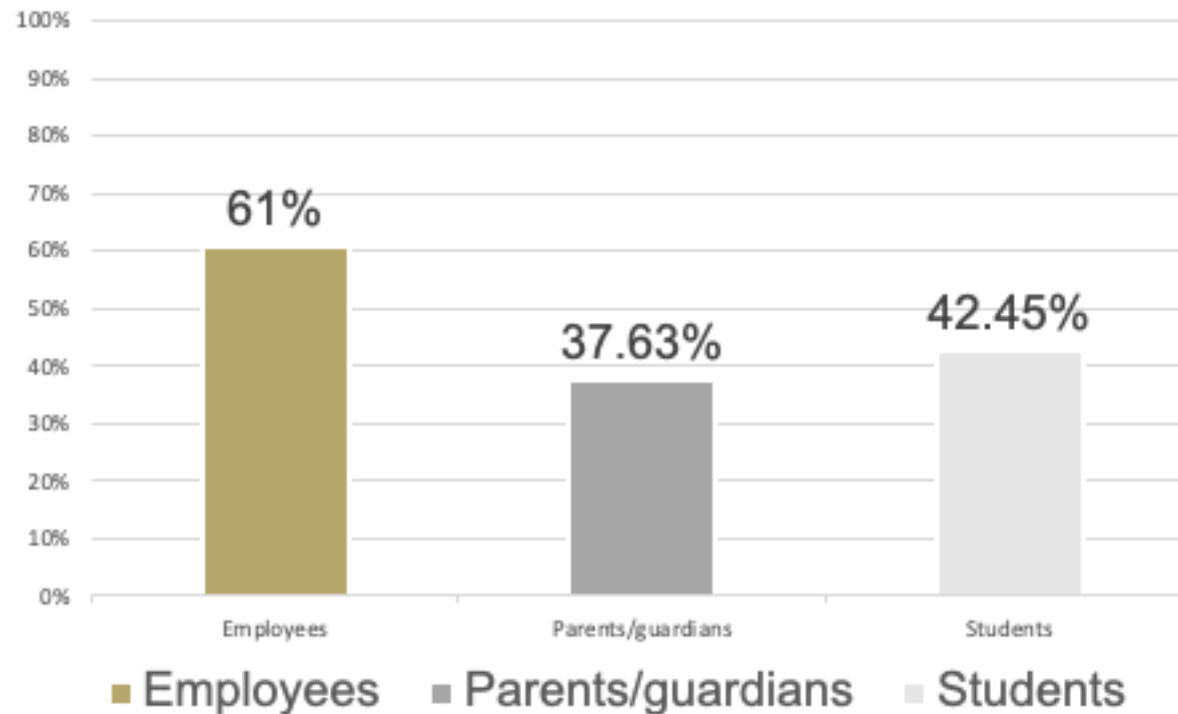


Reported access to eLearning materials as *quite* or *extremely* easy:

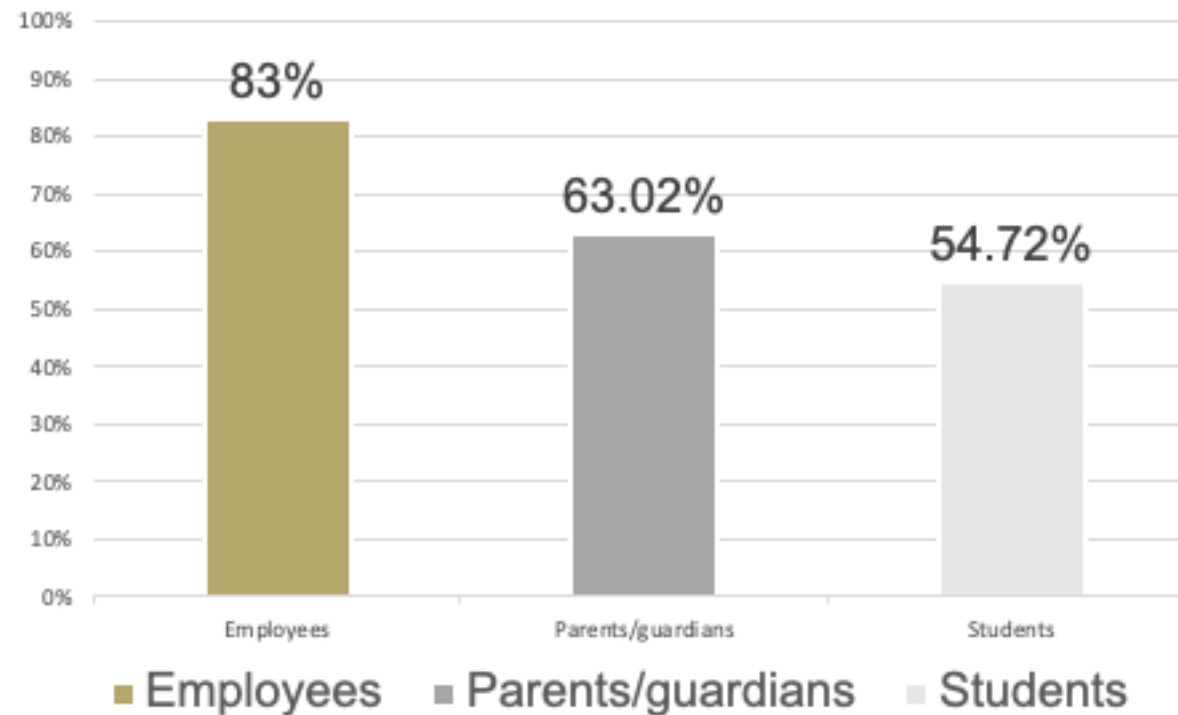

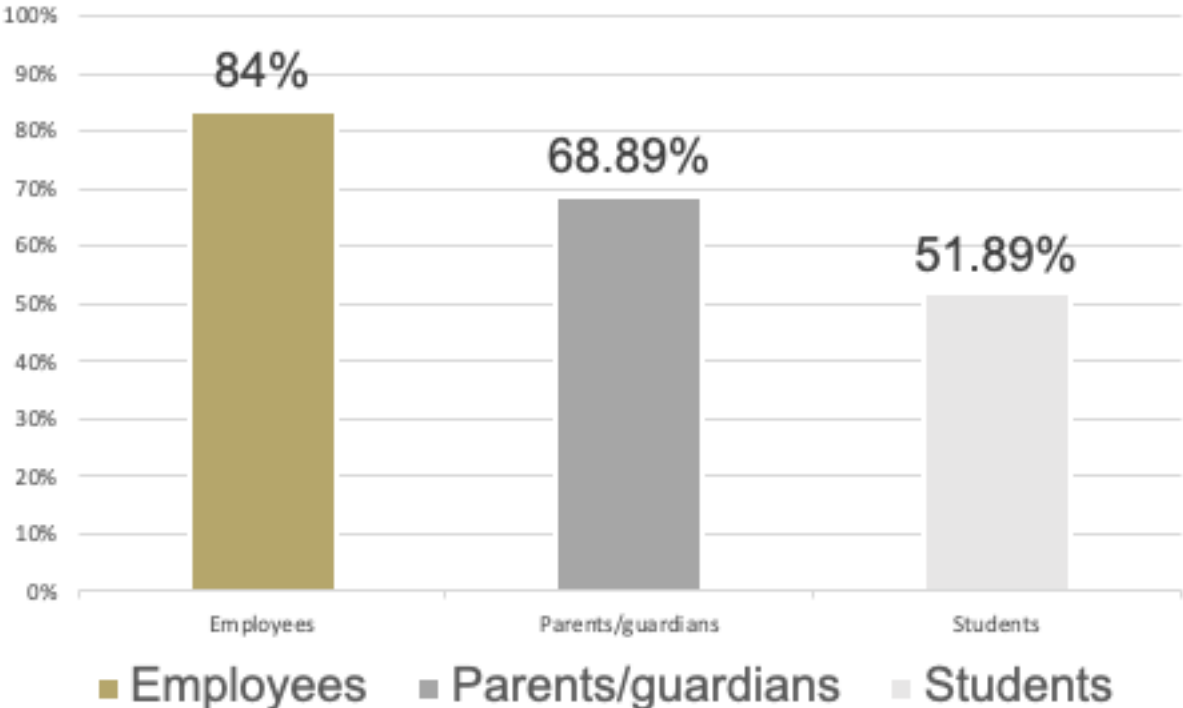
Reported *satisfied* or *extremely satisfied* with eLearning lessons and materials:

Reported *satisfied* or *extremely satisfied* with communication from district:

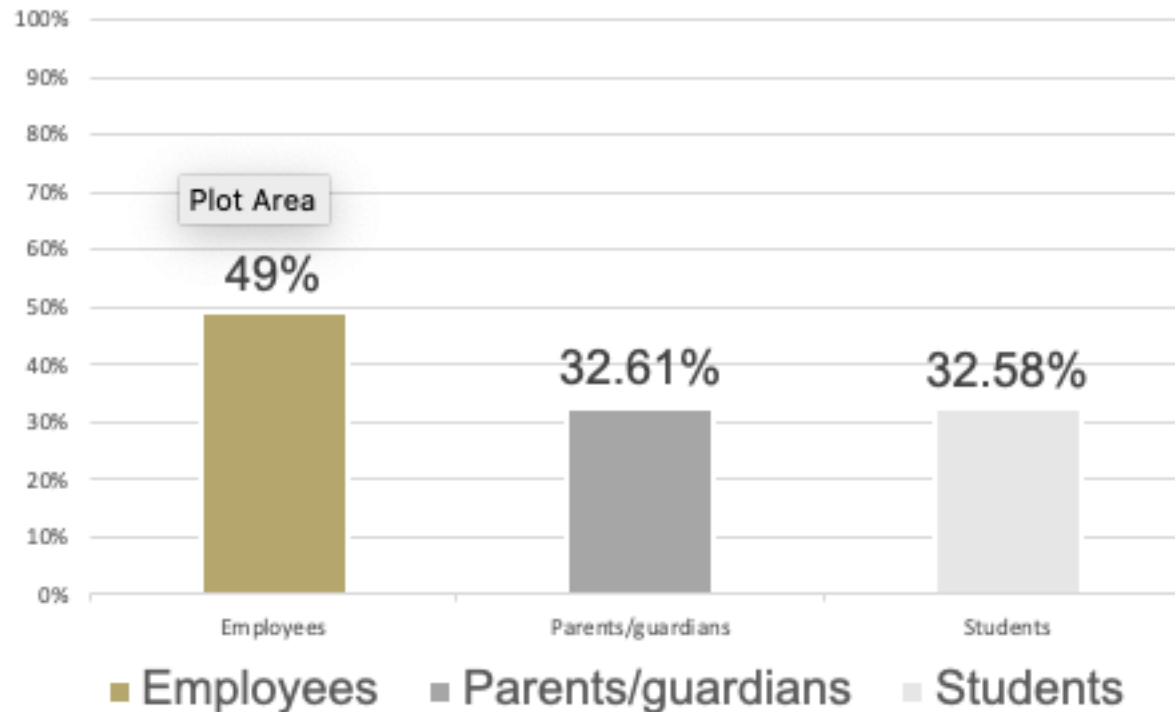

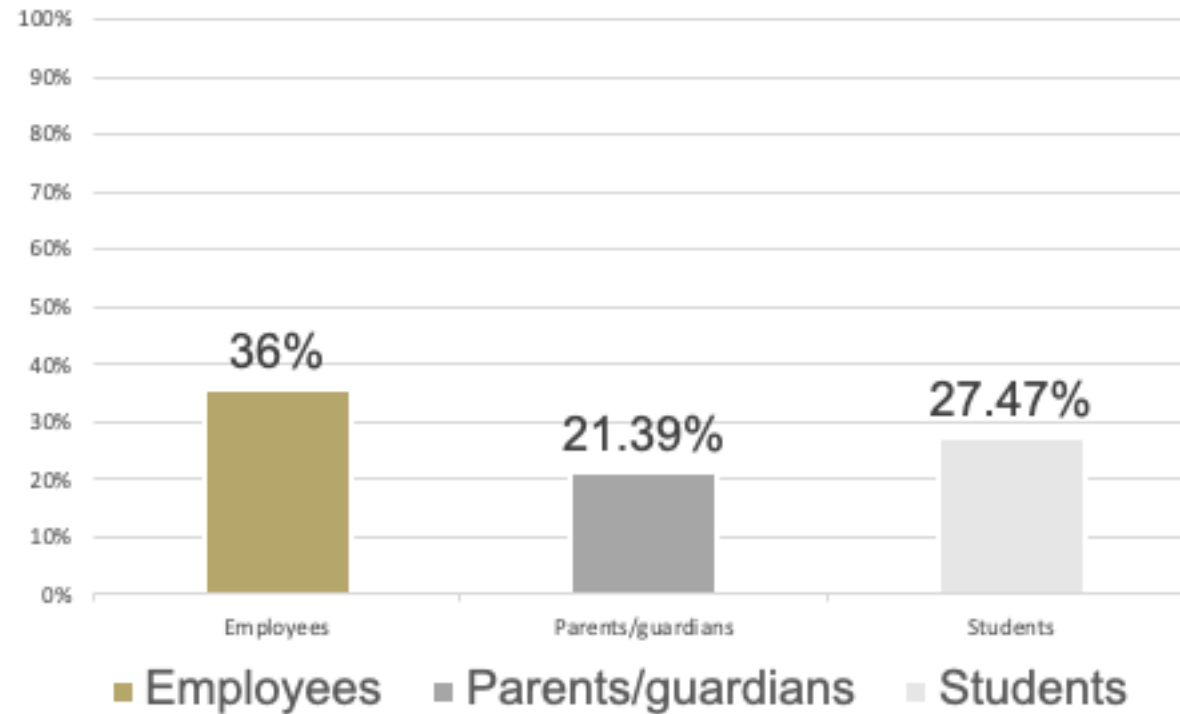

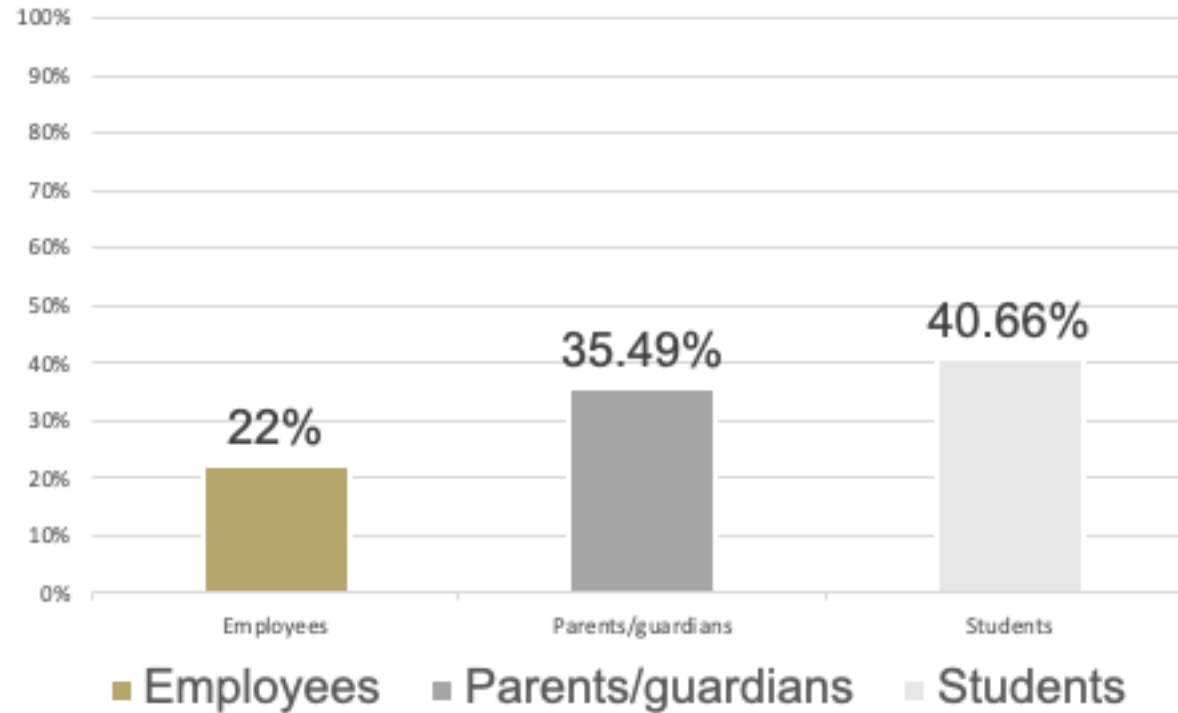
Reported *quite* or *extremely* concerned with about health/safety upon return to school:

- **Assignments**

- Increase consistency of Canvas usage

- Request regular (frequent) checkpoints for missing assignments and due dates

- **Communication**

- Continue regular, consistent communication as plans are made

- **Needs**

- Appropriate precautions
- Virtual back-to-school events
- Additional training for teachers and parents for remote learning

- **PPE/Masks**

- 93 mentions of masks throughout
