

## CAMP STAFF

### DIRECTOR: KYLE BRUMETT

Kyle Brumett recently completed his fifth season as head coach of the storied Wabash College basketball program. Brumett came to Wabash from Defiance College where he has served as the men's basketball coach and assistant athletics director. He owns a career coaching record of 211-136. Through five seasons with the Little Giants, Brumett's teams have a 75-57 record. In his time at Wabash, he has already coached 1 NCAC Player of the Year, 3 NCAC Newcomer of the Year recipients and 8 All-NCAC performers. His teams have consistently excelled in the classroom as well by posting over a 3.3 team GPA since he took over as Head Coach. In six seasons, Brumett guided Defiance to a 103-57 record, a share of the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference title in 2014, and won the HCAC championship and earned an NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in 2010. Prior to his service to Defiance, Coach Brumett spent two seasons at Lakeland College, where his teams posted a combined record of 33-22 and won the 2008 NAC (Northern Athletics Conference) Championship.

### ASSISTANT DIRECTOR: PAT SULLIVAN

Pat Sullivan recently completed his fifth season as an assistant coach for the Little Giants. He came to Wabash from Defiance College, where he served as both a graduate and full-time assistant coach from 2009 to 2014. Pat worked as the recruiting coordinator, director of scouting, and assistant director of summer camps. Sullivan graduated from Denison University in 2009, earning a B.A. while majoring in communications and economics. He played basketball for the Big Red for four seasons and was selected to the NCAC All-Conference Honorable Mention Team in 2008, after posting a 10.6 points and 3.6 assists per game average.

### CAMP COACHING STAFF:

The rest of the camp staff will be made up of the Wabash coaching staff, current Wabash players, as well as other high school coach coaches and college players.

### FUNDAMENTAL STATIONS:

Each camper will receive individual coaching from our staff of current college coaches, players and local high school coaches. Our stations generally include shooting, offensive moves, ball handling, rebounding, defense and footwork.
